We have a tentative time scheduled for volunteers to go to Casa Montana.

That will be from **September 15, 2009 through Christmas.**

The specific dates will be worked out as volunteers show interest. People can come in and out during that time. If you can jump in, we need plumbers, anyone with building skills, and anyone who can help in any capacity: painting, driving to town for supplies, being a gopher on the job, cooking, shoveling sand, etc.
